‘Who do I call if...?’



1. Who do I call if I have a problem with my Social Security Disability Insurance or Supplemental Security Income cash benefits?

You can call Social Security’s toll free number: **1-800-772-1213**, or **TDD: 1-800-325-0778**. You may also call your local Social Security office.

2. Who do I call if I have a problem with Medicaid?

If you disagree with a healthcare decision that has been made, you can call the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration Office of Hearings and Appeals at **317-232-4404**. You may also send a letter to:

3. **Who do I call if I have a problem with Medicare?**

You can call Medicare's toll free number: **1-800-633-4227**.

4. **Who do I call if I have a problem with my subsidized rent when I begin working?**

The first step you should take when you begin working is to report your earnings to your landlord or apartment manager and work with them on issues that may arise. If you are not able to resolve the issue, you may also contact:
